Covid-19 updates

Mayor Adams has discontinued the risk level system for New York City. You can still find information at the <u>NYC Covid-19 site</u>, but without an indication of whether cases are at high, medium or low levels. Cases were at a medium risk level when the system ended on Tuesday, but have been rising again. We will be making masks optional for those who are vaccinated, but still encourage you to use the precautions that make you feel most protected and offer greatest protection to the most vulnerable.
